We continue this month with our focus on film noir — emphasizing its themes, the lighting, shadows and the black-and-white cinematography. Our film in September will be *Nicholas Ray's* **In a Lonely Place** (1950), starring Humphrey Bogart and Gloria Grahame.

In a Lonely Place stars Academy Award winner Humphrey Bogart as Dixon Steele, a down-on-his-luck studio scribe who reluctantly agrees to adapt a trashy bestseller to the silver screen. Rather than read the book himself, Steele convinces a star-struck hat-check girl to accompany him home and tell him the story in her own words. Later that night, Mildred is found murdered and Steele — who has a history of violent behavior — becomes the prime suspect. Fortunately for him, his sexy neighbor, Laurel Gray (Gloria Grahame) — who is physically attracted to the writer — lies to the police by providing Steele with an air-tight alibi. But is he truly innocent of Mildred's death or is Laurel destined to become the next victim of Steele's violent temper?
